

## What are the Life Saving Rules?





1. Always wear a seatbelt when in moving vehicles or mobile plant



7. Always use fall protection when working at heights greater than 1.8 metres



2. Never talk or text on a hand-held mobile phone when operating a vehicle or mobile plant



3. Always comply with permit to work requirements

4. Always verify isolations before

work commences



- 8. Always take action to prevent objects from falling where people or equipment may be below
- 9. Always complete an entry permit and obtain authorisation before entering a confined space
- 10. Never position yourself under a suspended load
