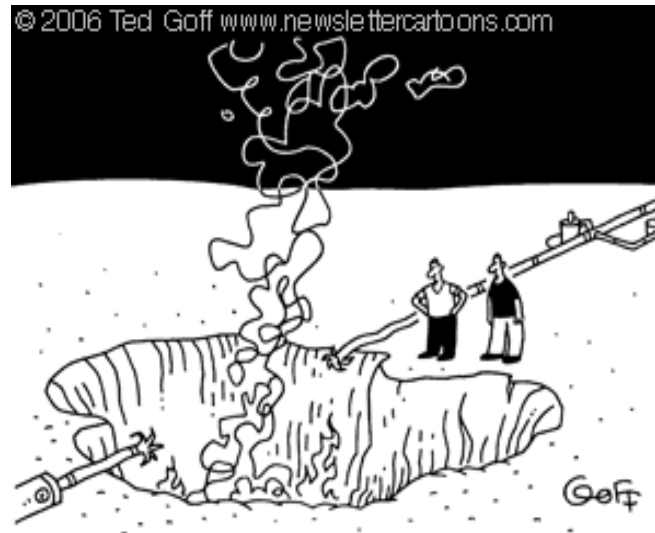

# What are the Life Saving Rules?



1. Always wear a seatbelt when in moving vehicles or mobile plant



7. Always use fall protection when working at heights greater than 1.8 metres



2. Never talk or text on a hand-held mobile phone when operating a vehicle or mobile plant



8. Always take action to prevent objects from falling where people or equipment may be below



3. Always comply with permit to work requirements



9. Always complete an entry permit and obtain authorisation before entering a confined space



4. Always verify isolations before work commences



10. Never position yourself under a suspended load



5. Always comply with signage and barricading



11. Always obtain authorisation before commencing excavation activities or entering an excavation deeper than 1.5 metres



6. Always obtain authorisation before overriding or disabling safety critical equipment
