- Long term planning high level schedules
- Medium term planning network/activity level schedules
- Short term planning work order level
- Early definition of: offshore hot work and work above open sea what require to be done in a shut dowm pre-shut down, shut down and post shut down activities
- Reductions and optimizations of simultaneous activities in an area

EPIM manages the ILAP project and PCA perform the standardization work.
